

SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Record,



- 1. The requested correction cannot be accomplished administratively at this headquarters.
- 2. The applicant is requesting 13 points be credited to make Retirement Year Ending (RYE) 26 March 1993 a year of satisfactory Federal service. The applicant is also requesting a correction of his Retention/Retirement(R/R) date.
- 3. The following is an analysis of the circumstances surrounding the case:
- a. The applicant was appointed in the Air Force Reserve on 27 March as an Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA). Member did not receive his appointment letter attaching him to Homestead AFB until 15 July 1992, approximately 5 months after his commissioning date. Member performed Inactive duty training (IDT) on 13 and 14 August 1992. Hurricane Andrew destroyed member's training facility at Homestead AFB on 23 August 1992. Member received a computer product from ARPC dated 12 January 1993 which stated his R/R date was 18 September, member scheduled his active duty and IDT training according to the 18 September R/R date. Member would have had a satisfactory year of Federal service for RYE 1993 if the R/R date would not have been changed. Member's record was audited and the R/R date was changed later to 27 March.
- b. For RYE 26 March 1993, member earned 0 Active duty (AD) points, 22 IDT points, 0 Extension Course Institute (ECI) points, 15 membership points and 37 total and retirement points.
- c. The $\ensuremath{\text{R/R}}$ date is established by law and therefore cannot be changed administratively.

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- d. In accordance with AFR 35-41, Vol 2, Paragraph 2.6.6, points may only be credited to the date a member actually performed the duty, except in those activities where the cumulative method is authorized.
- 4. We recommend this application be approved since member was participating in good faith. The combination of not receiving his appointment orders for 5 months and Hurricane Andrew destroying Homestead AFB, member's unit of operation, were factors that precluded member from additional participation and from earning a satisfactory year of Federal service.
- 5. If this application is approved, 13 points would be credited to make RYE 26 March 1993 a year of satisfactory Federal service.
- 6. The additional year of service would allow member to complete 20 years of satisfactory service by his $60^{\rm th}$ birthday.
- 7. If this application is disapproved, no further action is necessary.
