SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Record

- 1. The requested correction cannot be accomplished administratively at this headquarters.
- **2.** The applicant is requesting satisfactory service be granted for Retirement Year Ending (RYE) 11 June **1998.**
- **3.** The following is an analysis of the circumstances surrounding the case:
- a. Applicant was in the United States Air Force Reserve and United States Air Force from 12 June 1984 through 28 November 1996. was assigned to the Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA) program on 29 November 1996.
- b. Applicant states that Fiscal Year requirement was planned and approved by Air Force Reserve Commander. Civilian job was **also** scheduled around this plan.
- c. Applicant's original Retention/Retirement (R/R) date was **29** November. received a letter late September **1997** stating R/R date had changed to **12** July, however, applicant was still able to meet the requirements.
- d. Applicant received a second letter October **1997** stating R/R date was being changed again to **12** June. This would affect satisfactory year for the RYE 11 June **1998**.
- e. For RYE 11 June 1998, applicant earned 28 Active Duty (AD) points, 2 Inactive Duty Training (IDT) points, 0 Extension Course Institution (ECI) points and 15 membership points for 45 total and retirement points and an unsatisfactory year of Federal service.

- **4.** Recommend this application be approved since applicant was participating in good faith. The applicant completed original R/R date requirements that were approved by Commander. Because ARPC changed R/R date the applicant's RYE 12 June 1998 became an unsatisfactory year of service. The applicant would have had a satisfactory year of service with the 12 July R/R date.
- **5.** If this application is approved, award 5 non-paid IDT points for RYE 11 June 1998. The applicant's record would then show 28 AD points, 7 IDT points, 0 ECI points and 15 membership points resulting in 50 total and retirement points and a year of satisfactory Federal service for RYE 11 June 1998.
- 6. If this application is disapproved, no further action is necessary.
