## AIR FORCE BOARD FOR CORRECTION OF MILITARY RECORDS

The applicant requests that the award of the Vietnam Campaign Medal be added to his DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge. Applicant's submission is at Exhibit A.

The appropriate Air Force office evaluated applicant's request and provided an advisory opinion to the Board recommending the application be denied (Exhibit C). The advisory opinion was forwarded to the applicant for review and response (Exhibit D). As of this date, no response has been received by this office.

After careful consideration of applicant's request and the available evidence of record, we find insufficient evidence of error or injustice to warrant corrective action. The facts and opinions stated in the advisory opinion appear to be based cn the evidence of record and have not been adequately rebutted- by applicant. Absent persuasive evidence applicant was denied rights to which entitled, app-opriate regulations were not followed, or appropriate standards were not applied, we find no basis to disturb the existing record. Accordingly, applicant's request is denied.

The Board staff is directed tc inform applicant of this decision. Applicant should also be informed tnat this decision is final and will only be reconsidered upon the presentation of new relevant evidence which was not reasonably available at the time the application was filed.
