Applicant that his records be corrected to reflect that he completed his full term of service; and/or his narrative reason for separation be changed to convenience of the government under the early release program. Applicant's submission is at Exhibit A.

The appropriate Air Force offices evaluated applicant's request and provided advisory opinions to the Board recommending the application be denied (Exhibit C). The advisory opinions were forwarded to the applicant for review and response (Exhibit D). As of this date, no response has been received by this office.

After careful consideration of applicant's request and the available evidence of record, we find insufficient evidence of error or injustice to warrant corrective action. The facts and opinions stated in the advisory opinions appear to be based on the evidence of record and have not been rebutted by applicant. Absent persuasive evidence applicant was denied rights to which entitled, appropriate regulations were not followed, or appropriate standards were not applied, we find no basis to disturb the existing record.

Accordingly, applicant's request is denied.

The Board staff is directed to inform applicant of this decision. Applicant should also be informed that this decision is final and will only be reconsidered upon the presentation of new relevant evidence which was not reasonably available at the time the application was filed.

SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records

The applicant, while serving in the grade of senior airman, was separated from the Air Force *06* Aug 97 under the provisions of AFR **39-10** (Voluntary-MiscellaneousReasons) with an Honorable discharge. He served 05 years, 08 months total active service.

<u>Reauested Action</u>. The applicant is requesting his DD Form **214** be corrected to reflect completion of first full term of service or release for the convenience of the government under an early release program.

<u>Basis for Request.</u> Applicant claims the present status of his DD Form **214** wrongfully denies his eligibility for **UCX** benefits.

<u>Facts.</u> The applicant voluntarily requested early separation from the Air Force for miscellaneous reasons and the request was approved for his separation to be effective **06 Aug** 97. The Air Force approved just what he ask for at the time of his application. **His** enlistment contract (DD Form **4)** confirms that he enlisted for *six* (**6**) years and he requested voluntary early separation at the 5 years and **08** months point **and** therefore, did not complete his first full term of service. In addition, he **was** not separated under an early release program for the convenience of the government.

<u>Discussion</u>. **This** case has been reviewed for separation processing and there are no errors or irregularities causing an injustice to the applicant. His discharge complies with directives in effect at the time of his discharge. The records indicate member's military service was reviewed and appropriate action was taken.

<u>Recommendation</u>. Applicant did not identify any specific errors in the discharge processing nor provide facts **which** warrant a change in his reason for separation or the removal of the statement that he did not complete his first **full** term of service. Accordingly, we recommend applicant's request be denied. He has filed a timely request.

SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records -

The attached file is forwarded to you for final action. Or office has primary responsibility for establishing Air Force policy on unemployment compensation for exservicemembers (UCX). We interpret the law and determine which separation narratives fall within the statutory eligibility criteria.

Title **5**, United States Code, is the legal basis for Air Force policy. It establishes basic UCX eligibility by providing conditions of separation that would qualify for unemployment compensation. Members who separate without completing their first full term must have separated for convenience of the government under an early release program; hardship; medical disqualification, service incurred injury/disability, parenthood **or** pregnancy; or inaptitude or personality disorder. The Air Force determines which separation narratives would qualify for UCX under these criterion.

Reasons." As such, the separation narrative is not among those making an ex-service member eligible for UCX. We do not have authority to recommend approval or disapproval of a request to change a narrative reason for separation. If the board elects to change the member's separation reason and questions arise concerning the UCX eligibility of the proposed new separation narrative, we will advise the board on the UCX status of the proposed narrative.
