SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records [REDACTED]

Requested Action and Basis for Request. Reinstate 13 days charged as leave upon arrival at [REDACTED]. Applicant states finance charged leave because she did not sign in at the unit immediately upon arriving at Langley AFB and before house hunting.

Facts and Discussion. The travel voucher shows applicant departed [REDACTED] on 8 Nov 97. Finance charged 13 days leave for 8 - 20 Nov 97. The memorandum from the unit shows applicant arrived at [REDACTED] at 1800 on 10 Nov 97 and reported in at the unit on 12 Nov since 11 Nov was Veterans' day. It also shows applicant was authorized 8 days PTDY for house hunting purposes, and supports granting relief because the applicant was not on regular leave status 8 - 20 Nov 97. Air Force policy allows the gaining commander to grant up to 8 days PTDY for house hunting after the member arrives and signs in at the new duty station. In this case, we support granting relief because finance would not have charged leave if the applicant had signed in immediately upon arriving at [REDACTED].

Recommendation. Approve restoring 13 days to current leave account.
