Applicant requests (1) The amended AF Form 366, Record of Proceedings of Vacation of Suspended Nonjudicial Punishment, dated 11 December 1987 be placed in his official record, and (2) his record be corrected to reflect the appropriate offenses, if any, on the AF Form 3070, Record of Nonjudicial Punishment Proceedings, and an acknowledgment be placed in the record that he was unlawfully or incorrectly denied the right to see his child. Applicant's submission is at Exhibit A.

The appropriate Air Force office evaluated applicant's request and provided an advisory opinion 'o the Board recommending the application be denied (Exhibit C). The advisory opinion was forwarded to the applicant for review and response (Exhibit D). Applicant's response to the advisory opinion is at Exhibit E.

After careful consideration of applicant's request and the available evidence of record, we find insufficient evidence of error or injustice to warrant corrective action. The facts and opinions stated in the advisory opinion appear to be based on the evidence of record and have not been adequately rebutted by applicant. Absent persuasive evidence applicant was denied rights to which entitled, appropriate regulations were not followed, or appropriate standards were not applied, we find no basis to disturb the existing fecore.

Accordingly, applicant's request is denied.

The Board staff is directed to inform applicant of this decision. Applicant should also be informed that this decision is final and will only be reconsidered upon the presentation of new relevant evidence which was not reasonably available at the time the application was filed.
