SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records - [REDACTED]

**Requested Action and Basis for Request.** Reinstate 4 days of leave charged en route to and from the TDY location. Applicant states travel personnel misinformed him regarding allowable travel time, resulting in charged leave for travel days.

**Facts and Discussion.** Applicant drove from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] to attend Principles of Instructions Course, 28 Apr - 9 May 97 (14 days). Finance charged leave for 2 days, 25-26 Apr 97 after departing [REDACTED] and charged leave for 2 days after departing [REDACTED]. Finance charged leave because authorized travel time for TDYs of less than 16 days in length is 1 day to and 1 day from the TDY location. Applicant, however, states that base travel personnel informed him before departing [REDACTED] that he would be authorized 3 days' travel each way. The base financial management office provides statement indicating inexperienced travel technicians could have given the applicant inaccurate information, and supports reinstating the charged leave. In this case, we support granting relief.

**Recommendation.** Restore 4 days to current leave account.
