SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records-

The attached application for correction to military records submitted by the applicant, a member of the Air National Guard, is forwarded for your review and action. The applicant requests adjustment in Grade and Time-in-Grade for relevant education and experience upon transfer from an Army line Officer position to an Air Force professional position.

This Headquarters recommends relief. The applicant was appointed in the Air National Guard on 2 Dec 95. His constructive service credit was computed by ANG/DPPSO using an incorrect authority. In accordance with AFI 36-2005, the member was an Army National Guard (line) officer requesting to transfer to the Air National Guard (Medical Service Corp). Therefore, his constructive service credit should have been computed IAW AFI 36-2005, Table 21.3 Rule 6. The member's constructive service credit has been recomputed as follows: Master Degree, Business Administration, (AFI 36-2005, Table 2.5 Rule 39, 2 years, 0 months and 0 days) and Army National Guard – line officer, (AFI 36-2005, Table 2.5, Rule 45, 1 years, 2 months, and 23 days). The Masters Degree and the Army National Guard credit totals 3 years, 2 months and 23 days.

The member should have been appointed in the Air National Guard as a First Lieutenant. Therefore, this Headquarters recommends changing the following dates, First Lieutenant, TYSD to 9 Sep 92 (Date of Appointment backdated 3 years 2 months and 23 days), PSD 9 Sep 95, TFCSD 17 Jun 93 (unchanged).
