



- 1. The requested correction cannot be accomplished administratively at this headquarters.
- 2. The applicant requests Reserve Order discharging on 14 March 1985, be amended to reflect 15 March 1985. This modification would eliminate a 1-day break in service and change Retention/Retirement (R/R) date from the current date of 16 March 1985 to 16 October 1984.
- 3. The following is an analysis of the circumstances surrounding the case:
- a. Applicant was relieved from active duty on 15 October 1984 and transferred to the U.S. Air Force Reserve to complete obligation. The original DD Form 4 was signed on 15 March 1979 for 6 years, giving a Military Service Obligation (MSO) date of 14 March 1985.
- b. Applicant reenlisted on 16 March 1985 based on the MSO date of 15 March 1985, which was on DD 214. believed during successive periods of service all the dates were chosen to prevent a break in service.
- c. An audit was performed in November 1997 changing R/R date from 16 October 1984 to 16 March 1985 giving the member break in service. This change caused the time period of 16 October 1984 to 14 March 1985 to be unsatisfactory service.
- **4.** We recommend this application be approved since applicant was participating in good faith on a R/R date of 16 October from 1984 to 1997 and all time was considered satisfactory service.

- 5. If the AFBCMR agrees with our recommendation, take the following actions:
 - a. Amend Reserve Order to show discharge date of 15 March 1985.
- . b. Change R/R date back to 16 October date. This would make the time period 16 October 1984 to $14\,\mathrm{March}\ 1985$ satisfactory service.
