The applicant requests a constructive reenlistment to permit retirement the first day of the month following High Year of Tenure (HYT). He filed a timely request within three years of discovering the alleged injustice.

Title 10, USC 509 restricts an airman from extending any one enlistment in excess of 48 months. The applicant extended his **3**1 Oct 1989 (six-year) enlistment a total of 42 months. He needs an additional 11 months to retire effective 1 Mar 2000. We give this date since it is the first day of the month following the applicant's HYT month of Feb 2000.

We recommend the applicant be given relief by granting him a two-year, 1 Mar 1998 constructive reenlistment. This would establish his date of separation as 29 Feb 2000 and permit retirement effective 1 Mar 2000.
