SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Record (DD Form 149-6) [REDACTED]

Requested Action: [REDACTED] is requesting 9 days leave be restored to his leave account.

Basis for Request: [REDACTED] en-route training class start date at [REDACTED] AFB, [REDACTED] was changed after he had departed his last duty station. He states he was placed in an involuntary leave status because of this change.

Background: While at [REDACTED] AFB, [REDACTED] was selected for an assignment to AFELM NATO/AFSOUTH, [REDACTED] with training en-route located at [REDACTED] AFB, [REDACTED]. He had a scheduled class start date of 27 August 1997.

Facts: AETC changed the Advanced Communications Officer Training Course (ACOT) FY97 class schedules on 4 August 1998, which caused [REDACTED] ACOT class start date to change from 27 August 1997 to 9 September 1997. AETC announced this change of class start dates 8 days after [REDACTED] had departed his permanent duty station [REDACTED] AFB, [REDACTED]. While on leave [REDACTED] was notified of the change and he asked the [REDACTED] AFB MPF (SRA [REDACTED]/DPMARO) if he should return to [REDACTED] AFB because of the later class start date. He was advised he could not be gained back to his unit at [REDACTED] AFB, therefore, he should comply with the new class start date reporting instructions. He also contacted the [REDACTED] Training Squadron at [REDACTED] AFB and asked what his options were because of the change in class start date? He was told by a representative of the [REDACTED] Training Squadron that he was not alone in these circumstances and the change in his class start date was necessary so as to align the class dates with other events (Scope Warrior/Scope Eagle). In addition, due to extremely limited billeting facilities at [REDACTED] AFB he should report as directed. He followed the new instructions and reported to [REDACTED] AFB on 9 Sep 97.

Recommendation: Restore 9 days leave to [REDACTED] leave account.
