Applicant requests that [redacted]'s Officer Performance Report (OPR) dated 1996 be corrected to [redacted] December [redacted] [redacted] inclusion of previously excluded information cited in Section 10 of the form; he be granted a Special Review Board with [redacted] [redacted] records, and, upon selection for promotion, he be returned to the Reserve Active Status List [redacted] the Retired Reserve and assigned to an appropriate [redacted] A or B position. [redacted] submission [redacted] at Exhibit A.

The appropriate [redacted] Force office evaluated applicant's [redacted] and provided an advisory opinion [redacted] the [redacted] [redacted] the application be denied (Exhibit C). The advisory opinion was forwarded to the applicant [redacted] review and response (Exhibit D). As of this date, no response has been received by this office.

[redacted] consideration of applicant's request and the available evidence of record, we find insufficient evidence of [redacted] or injustice [redacted] warrant corrective action. The facts and opinions stated in the [redacted] opinions appear [redacted] be based on the evidence [redacted] and have not been rebutted by applicant. Absent persuasive evidence applicant was [redacted] rights to which entitled, appropriate [redacted] were not followed, or appropriate standards were not applied, we find no basis to disturb the existing record.

Accordingly, applicant's request [redacted] denied.

The Board staff is directed to inform applicant of this decision. Applicant should also be informed that this decision is final and will only be reconsidered upon the presentation of new relevant evidence which was not reasonably available at the time the application was filed.
