SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Record,

1. The requested correction cannot be accomplished administratively at this headquarters.
2. The applicant is requesting that 13, 14, and 21 January 1997 (6 Inactive Duty Training (IDT) points) be credited to service year 1997 (Retirement Year Ending (RYE) 28 January 1998), to avoid a bad service year.
3. The following is an analysis of the circumstances surrounding the case:
 - a. The applicant's Retention/Retirement (R/R) date is 29 January. This resulted in the 3 referenced dates being credited to RYE 28 January 1997.
 - b. The applicant states was unaware that days prior to 29 January 1997 would not go towards . 1997 year and that none of the Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA) managers previously assigned to unit were aware of it either.
 - c. The applicant has been participating in the IMA program since 29 January 1990. In all those years except the one referenced in paragraph 2 above, the applicant began participation after R/R date and earned enough points for satisfactory years of service. If the applicant had delayed the referenced 3 IDT days for just 3 weeks would have had a year of satisfactory service.

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d. The applicant's Commander has also stated in the memorandum for HQ ARPC, dated 17 July 1998, (included in the applicant's application for correction) the applicant and the IMA program managers were unaware of the mandatory time frame restrictions and requests approval of the applicant's request

4. Recommend this application be approved based on the applicant was participating in good faith, the request of the applicant's Commander, and the Commander's statement that new procedures have been implemented to ensure this type of oversight does not occur again.

5. If this application is approved, award 5 non-paid IDT points for RYE 28 January 1998. The applicant's record would then show 12 Active Duty points, 23 IDT points, 0 Extension Course Institute points and 15 membership points resulting in 50 total and retirement points and a year of satisfactory Federal service.

6. If this application is disapproved, no further action is necessary.
