SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records 4

This responds to your request for a BCMR advisory of the who is requesting his records be changed to indicate he is authorized payment for PCS travel that occurred prior to the effective date of his Extended Active Duty Order.

By way of background arriving arriving 11 Jul 98, despite the fact that his orders specifically stated that the effective date of duty was on or after 15 Jul 98 and he was to report no later than 2400 on 15 Jul 98. However, it should be noted the orders did not state that early reporting to the permanent duty station was not authorized.

DD Form 149 and his attached letter both state he was under the impression that travel was to be completed before effective date on the orders. In addition, was not informed by personnel at his ROTC detachment that he should not travel prior to the effective date of his orders. In light of this information we recommend the board approve this request. If the board decides to grant the request we suggest the records be changed to reflect that PCS travel was performed on or after 15 Jul 98 and the point of contact for this advisory is
