Requested Action and Basis for Request. Restore 14 days charged leave based on authorization for 14 days convalescent leave.

Facts and Discussion. Applicant charged 34 days leave, 14 Mar - 16 Apr 98, en route to his new assignment at [REDACTED]. He underwent an appendectomy while on leave and, on 18 Mar 98, the attending physician authorized 14 days convalescent leave and 30 days light duty. In this case, we support granting relief based on the authorization for 14 days convalescent leave.

Recommendation. Restore 14 days to current leave account.
