The Joint Federal Travel Regulations, Volume I (JFTR), Chapter 4, Part C, Paragraph U4210-B5 allows the Director of PDTATAC for special or unusual circumstances, or the Secretary concerned for specific classified locations, to authorize reimbursement in excess of 300 percent of the prescribed per diem rate. This authorization must be granted in advance.

The office of the Vice President has verified that circumstances prevented from obtaining prior approval of AEA for lodging costs exceeding the 300 percent limit. We recommend approval of the state of request for authorization of lodging costs in excess of 300 percent. If approval is granted record should be corrected to reflect that AEA approval in excess of 300 percent was granted on 4 Aug 98. Action office is
