<u>Requested Action and Basis for Request.</u> Restore 8 days charged leave **2 - 9** Aug **98**. Applicant states this should be PTDY for house hunting upon arrival at Langley AFB VA.

<u>Facts and Discussion</u>. Air Force policy authorizes PTDY for house hunting purposes either before signing out of the old station or after signing in at the new station. Applicant provided copy of AF Form **988** dated **13** Aug **98** and signed by her commander authorizing PTDY for house hunting following arrival at the provided control of 1 Aug **98**. Applicant did the house hunting before signing in at the unit. Therefore, finance charged 8 days leave **2-9** Aug **98**. In this case, we support granting relief because military personnel flight personnel misinformed the applicant to do her house hunting and then sign in at her unit.

<u>Recommendation</u>. Approve restoring 8 days to current leave account.
