AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

CASE NUMBER

FD02-0292

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to Honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains the available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The board finds that neither evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety, which would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant does not contest her discharge. She indicates that she had an alcohol problem and is now attending alcoholics anonymous and would like her discharge upgraded in order to get on with her life. The record indicates the applicant received an Article 15 for consuming alcoholic beverages while under the legal drinking age and by wrongfully allowing members of the opposite sex to enter her dormitory living quarters. In addition, the applicant received two Letters of Reprimand. One for smoking in uniform, not in possession of an AETC Form 341, and intentionally using the wrong name. The other was for underage drinking and allowing a male in the female hallway. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The Board found no evidence of any inequity or impropriety on which to base a decision to upgrade the discharge.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.



- 1. We have reviewed this discharge case file and find it legally sufficient to support discharge in accordance with the provisions of AFI 36-3208. Based upon our review, we conclude that the incidents documented within this file sufficiently support Amnuscher discharge from the Air Force. We concur with the 362 TRS/CCQ that Amnuscher should be discharged with an under honorable conditions (general) discharge in accordance with AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.49 (minor disciplinary infractions).
- 2. <u>Basis for Action</u>. On 29 Nov 01, the 362 TRS/CCQ notified Amn that she was recommending that Amn be discharged from the service due to her misconduct.
- 3. Evidence for the Commander. The preponderance of the evidence in the case file supporting the squadron section commander's recommendation consists of the following:
- a. The respondent did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 6 Oct 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: paragraph 2.1.9, SAFBI 36-2902, dated 15 Oct 97, by wrongfully allowing members of the opposite sex to enter her dormitory living quarters. For this misconduct and subparagraph "b" below, she received an Article 15 on 29 Oct 01.
- b. The respondent did, at or near Wichita Falls TX, on or about 22 Sep 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: paragraph 2.1.11, SAFBI 36-2902, dated 15 Oct 97, by wrongfully consuming alcoholic beverages while under the legal drinking age of 21.
- c. The respondent did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 7 Sep 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: paragraph 2.1.11, SAFBI 36-2902, dated 15 Oct 97, by wrongfully consuming alcoholic beverages while under the legal drinking age of 21. wrongfully smoking while in uniform. For this misconduct and subparagraph "f' below, she received an LOR on 24 Aug 01.

- f. The respondent did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 24 Aug 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: SAFBI 36-2902, paragraph 2.1.1, dated 15 Oct 97, by failing to carry at least two properly filled out AETC Forms 341 at all times
- 4. Additional Information. The respondent is 20 years old, began her present enlistment on 7 Mar 01, and was assigned to her unit on 23 Apr 01. Her ASVAB scores are as follows: A 48, E 55, G 55, and M 52. The respondent is entitled to wear the Air Force Training Ribbon. She has waived her rights to consult with counsel and has waived her rights to submit statements for your consideration.
- 5. We note no administrative errors and concur with the squadron section commander's recommendation for an under honorable conditions (general) discharge.
- 6. In accordance with AFI 36-3208, your options are to:
 - a. Direct Amn retention;
- b. Suspend an under honorable conditions (general) discharge and recommend Probation and Rehabilitation;
 - c. Direct her discharge with an under honorable conditions (general) discharge; or
- d. Recommend that Amn be discharged with an honorable discharge. If you determine an honorable discharge is appropriate, this file must be forwarded to 2 AF/CC since only a General Court-Martial Convening Authority may approve an honorable discharge characterization when the basis for discharge is misconduct (AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.48.4).

- e. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 23 Aug 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: paragraph 2.1.12, SAFBI 36-2902, dated 15 Oct 97, by wrongfully smoking while in uniform. For this misconduct and subparagraph "f" below, you received a LOR on 24 Aug 01.
- f. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 24 Aug 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: SAFBI 36-2902, paragraph 2.1.1, dated 15 Oct 97, by failing to carry at least two properly filled out AETC Forms 341 at all times

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising Special Court Martial jurisdiction or higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if

you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and will probably be denied enlistment in any component of the armed forces.

- 3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult <u>capt</u> Area Defense Counsel, at Bldg 1638, room 110, on <u>3000001</u> at <u>1400</u> hours. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by \(\frac{1}{2} \) \(\frac{1}{2} \) \(\frac{1}{2} \) unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to separation authority.
- 5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 6. You were scheduled for a physical examination on 29 nov. at 1430
- 7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208, is available for your use in the 362 TRS/Commanders Support Staff office.
