### AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD2001-0537

**GENERAL:** The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to Honorable.

The applicant appeared and testified before the Discharge Review Board (DRB), without counsel, at Travis AFB, CA on February 6, 2003. His father, SH, was present to testify on his behalf. The following additional exhibits were submitted at the hearing:

Exhibit 5: Applicant's contentions.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

**FINDINGS**: The Board denies the requested relief, however the reason for discharge is changed to personality disorder.

The Board finds that neither evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an impropriety and inequity that would justify upgrade of the discharge, however the Board concludes that change of the reason for discharge is justified.

**ISSUES**: The applicant was discharged with a General Discharge for misconduct, minor disciplinary infractions. The records indicated the applicant received one Article 15 for underage drinking and driving under the influence and three letters of counseling and three letters of reprimand for several incidents reporting late for duty, underage drinking and derogatory language towards a noncommissioned officer. The applicant was diagnosed with Social Anxiety Disorder and Personality Disorder Not Otherwise Specified with Avoidant and Schizotypal traits in addition to alcohol abuse/dependence. The applicant's Area Defense Counsel at the time of his discharge argued for changing the basis for discharge to unsuitability due to personality disorder with an honorable characterization of service noting that his misconduct was related to his personality disorder. The applicant contends he was young and immature, that his alcohol abuse impaired his ability to serve, and that his misconduct was of minor and isolated offenses. The Board noted that in spite of his alcohol abuse and personality disorder he still knew right from wrong and was responsible for his actions and must be held accountable. Despite mental health counseling, repeated counseling by his supervisors and ample opportunities to improve his behavior, he failed to respond to rehabilitative efforts. The existence of a character and behavior disorder does not preclude administrative separation for other reasons including misconduct. The Board opined that administrative separation for unsuitability, personality disorder, would have been a more accurate basis for discharge but also concluded that his recurring misconduct never the less formed a sufficient basis for characterizing his service as general.

**CONCLUSIONS:** The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

However, in view of the foregoing findings, the Board concludes that the reason for discharge is accurately described as personality disorder but concurs that the overall character of the applicant's service is accurately reflected by a General Discharge. The applicant's reason for discharge should be changed to Personality Disorder under the provisions of Title 10, USC 1553.


## 2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On or about 27 May 00, you were observed by another member in your unit drinking while underage. On or about 1 Jun 00, you offered money to the individual if he would retract his statement about seeing you drunk. For these offenses you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR), dated 6 Jun 00.
- b. On or about 20 Apr 00, you failed to go at the prescribed time to your appointed place of duty. For this offense you received a Letter of Counseling (LOC), dated 20 Apr 00.
- c. On or about 24 Mar 00, you used derogatory language towards another noncommissioned officer. For this offense you received an LOR, dated 17 Apr 00.
- d. On or about 17 Feb 00, you failed to go at the prescribed time to your appointed place of duty. For this offense you received an LOR, dated 17 Feb 00.
- e. On or about 15 Dec 99, you failed to go at the prescribed time to your appointed place of duty. For this offense you received an LOC, dated 15 Dec 99.
- f. On or about 10 Oct 99, you drank while underage and drove a vehicle while drunk. For these offense you received an Article 15, dated 26 Oct 99, reduction to the grade of airman with a new date of rank of 26 Oct 99, and an Unfavorable Information File (UIF) was established.
- g. On or about 6 Oct 99, you failed to go at the prescribed time to your appointed place of duty. For this offense you received an LOC, dated 7 Oct 99.
- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you are discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force, and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.
