AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD2002-0089

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to Honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge to Honorable is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record or that provided by the applicant substantiates an impropriety or inequity that would justify upgrade of the discharge.

ISSUES: The applicant was discharged with an Under Other Than Honorable Conditions (UOTHC) Discharge. He was discharged in lieu of a Court Martial for being AWOL, failure to obey orders, destruction of personal property, and for wrongful use of marijuana. The applicant states that he had personal problems that led to his misconduct. The DRB took note of the applicant's duty performance as documented by his performance reports and other information contained in the records. They found the seriousness of the willful misconduct offset any positive aspects of the applicant's duty performance. The Board concluded the discharge was appropriate for the reasons that were the basis for this case. The DRB concluded that the characterization of the applicant's discharge was appropriate due to the misconduct.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.



He was absent from work, without authorization for 48 hrs, until our police apprehended him off base.
- 2. Article 86, Failure to Go & Article 92, Failure to Obey Order. On Monday, 4 Jun, I ordered SrA (1990) ordered the composition of the compositio
- 3. Article 112a, Wrongful Use of Marijuana. On Monday, 4 Jun, SrAmming confessed to our Security Police Investigators that he smoked marijuana. He willingly handed over a "bong" (drug paraphernalia) from his off-base residence (collaborating evidence).
- 4. Article 92, Fallure to Obey Order & Article 109, Destruction of Property other than Military. On 8 Jun, our commander, Lt Col Military issued a written No Contact order to SrAcial Proposition him from communicating with his wife. He signed to receipt for and acknowledged understanding of this order. On Saturday evening, at approximately 2130 hrs, SrAcial Eviolated the order. He discovered where his wife was staying and visited this residence. He contacted his wife by telephone several times in an attempt to get his ear from her. He visited the residence and when he became angry his wife closed the door on him. He then put his fist through the window. The replacement cost to the window is estimated at \$65. The Del City Police had to take him to MWC Regional where he received stitches in his arm.

SrA

1. SrA the late of the UCMJ.

After receiving the advice of an attorney, Capt Teresa L. Reed, Area Defense Counsel, SrA that requested to be discharged in lieu of trial by court-martial (Attach 1). The squadron commander, Lt Col Captal Supports the discharge with an under other than honorable conditions (UOTHC) characterization (Attach 3).

2. Although credible evidence exists to establish a case that SrA committed the charged offenses, many of the offenses are of a purely military nature and were committed under extreme emotional distress. While his mental state is a mitigating factor warranting some lesser disposition, it does not rise to the level of a lack of mental capacity or responsibility. Under these conditions, I believe that it is in the best interest of the Air Force to grant SrA Sanders' request for discharge in lieu of trial by court-martial. The charged offenses in this case are of such a serious nature that it merits a discharge under other than honorable conditions.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- a. The 72 ABW/CC recommend that the request for discharge in lieu of trial by court-martial be approved; and
- b. The OC-ALC/CC approve the under other than honorable conditions discharge in lieu of trial by general court-martial.



SUBJECT: Request for Discharge in Lieu of Trial by Court-Martial -

- 1. I have carefully reviewed all of the documentation pertaining to SrA and his request for administrative discharge in lieu of court-martial, dated 3 July 2001. I have also considered the recommendations of his commander and that of the Staff Judge Advocate.
- 2. I concur with the recommendations of the Staff Judge Advocate and the 752d Computer Systems Squadron Commander. Although the allegations are serious, there are significant mitigating mental health issues involved. Although his mental state does not rise to the level of a lack of competency or capacity, they do warrant consideration of a lesser disposition for his offenses. I believe that approving SrA sequest for discharge, with an under other than honorable conditions (UOTHC) characterization, is a fair and appropriate outcome to this case that will best serve the interests of the Air Force and the parties involved.
