GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to Honorable.
The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains the available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.
The board finds that neither evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety, which would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant does not contest the discharge; he merely wants it upgraded in order to receive his G.I. Bill benefits. The record indicates the applicant received two Article 15's for a DUI and assault. He also received a Vacation action of a suspended UCMJ action for failure to go. And, he received a Letter of Reprimand for playing his stereo too loud. The applicant cited his desire to receive the G.I. Bill benefits as justification for upgrade. The DRB noted that when the applicant applied for these benefits, he signed a statement that he understood he must receive an Honorable discharge to receive future educational entitlements. The Board was sympathetic to the impact the loss of these benefits was having on the applicant, but this is not a matter of inequity or impropriety that would warrant an upgrade. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate. The Board found no evidence of any inequity or impropriety on which to base a decision to upgrade the discharge.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Misconduct. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, para 5.49, Minor Disciplinary Infractions. This action could result in your separation with an Under Other Than Honorable Conditions discharge. I am recommending that your service be characterized as Under Honorable Conditions (General).
2. My reasons for this action are as follows:
a. You, did, at or near Marsure, Italy, on or about 3 Apr 98, conspire with commit an offense under the Uniform Code of Military Justice, to wit: assault, and in order to
effect the object of conspiracy, you, Senior Airman
Airman
from entering, and assault the said Airman First Class
nonjudicial punishment dated 6 May 98 , which included the following punishment: reduction to
the grade of E-1 (Airman Basic), suspended until 5 Nov 98 , after which time it will be remitted
without further action, unless sooner vacated; forfeiture of $\$ 250$ pay per month for two months;
and a reprimand.
b. You, did, at or near Aviano Air Base, Italy, on or about 4 Apr 98, with intent to deceive, make to Senior Master Sergeantmenne, an official statement, to wit: you did not see any fighting at all, which statement was totally false, and was then known by you to be so false. This offense is evidenced in your 6 May 98 nonjudicial punishment.
c. You ,did, at or near Marsure, Italy, on or about 3 Apr 98, assault Airman First Class by holding a door closed and preventing others from entering while Senior
 their fists and feet. This offense is evidenced in your 6 May 98 nonjudicial punishment.
d. You, did at Áviano Air Base, Italy, between on or about 31 Dec 97 and on or about 1 Jan 98, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty, to wit: the security police gate assigned to you by MSgt ..... NCOIC of Security Forces Law Enforcement, for the purpose of handing out fliers. For this offense, the suspended portion of your nonjudicial punishment dated 23 Dec 97 , reducing you to the grade of $\mathrm{E}-2$ (Airman) was vacated reducing your rank to Airman effective 23 Dec 97.
e. You, did, at or near Pordenone, Italy, on or about 6 Dec 97, physically control a vehicle, to wit: a passenger car, while the alcohol concentration in your blood was 0.10 grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood or greater, as shown by chemical analysis. For this offense, you received nonjudicial punishment dated 23 Dec 97, which included the following punishment: reduction to the grade of E-2 (Airman), suspended until 22 Jun 98 , unless sooner vacated; forfeiture of $\$ 505.00$ pay per month for two months; 45 days extra duty; and a reprimand.
f. On or about 15 Aug 97, you did violate the Aviano Air Base Dormitory Standards as set forth in Aviano Pamphlet 32-6001 by playing your stereo too loud. For this infraction, you received a Letter of Counseling dated 26 Aug 97.

I have attached copies of the supporting documents that will be forwarded to the separation authority. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force. If you are discharged, you may be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force. In addition, any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.
3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel is available to assist you. I have

4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by $/ 600$ hours on Z 29 M Ay 981998 unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will forward your statements to the separation authority.
5. If you fail to consult counsel, or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
6. You will report for two medical examinations. You are to report to the $31 \mathrm{FW} / \mathrm{SGOAF}$ (Physical Exams) on $\mathcal{Z T U N} 1998$ at $/ / D C$ hours. Your second appointment is on TBA 1998 at $\qquad$ hours. You will need to report 15 minutes prior to your appointment and pick-up your medical records.
7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act Statement of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the unit orderly room or ADC office.
8. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
