AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to Honorable, and change of reenlistment eligibility (RE) code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains the available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge and change of RE code are denied.

The board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety, which would justify a change of discharge.

The applicant's issues are listed in the attached brief.

Issue. Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was based on one isolated incident. The information provided by the applicant and contained in his records was carefully reviewed by the DRB. The records indicated that Special Court Martial charges were preferred. The misconduct included unlawfully striking his wife, adultery, and communicating a threat. The board concluded the misconduct outweighed the otherwise satisfactory performance of this member.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade and change of RE code, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. You are ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force if your discharge is approved.

3. You have the right to consult military counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Capter Capter Area Defense Counsel (ADC), on 9 Jan 96 at 1400 in Bldg 750. ADC can be reached at 4375.

4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by $\frac{12}{2}$ at $\frac{300}{2}$ unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.

6. You have been scheduled for two mandatory medical examinations. You are to report to the 22d Medical Group Physical Exams Section on 11 Jan 96 at 0730 and Flight Medicine on 11 Jan 96 at 0930. Take your records with you to both appointments. If you wear glasses take them with you to both appointments. If you wear contacts have them out 12 hours prior to both appointments.

7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in your squadron orderly room.
