**AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE**

CASE NUMBER

FD03-0020

**GENERAL:** The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to Honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains the available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

**FINDINGS:** Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The board finds that neither evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety, which would justify a change of discharge.

The applicant's issues are listed in the attached brief.

**ISSUE:** The applicant does not contest the discharge; he states that his conduct while in the Air Force was unacceptable. However, he would like to re-enlist in the Army. The record indicates the applicant received two Article 15's for Failure to go, wrongfully failing to remain on Sheppard AFB, wrongfully failing to remain in proper military uniform, and making a false official statement. And, for attempting to unlawfully enter the dorm room of another airman. In addition, he received a Letter of Reprimand for violation of room security standards, and failure to obey an order or regulation by not maintaining his dorm room in accordance within base guidelines. The Board concluded the misconduct of the applicant appropriately characterized his term of service. No inequity or impropriety in his discharge was suggested or found in the course of the records review. His misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The Board concluded that the character and reason for discharge were appropriate due to his misconduct.

**CONCLUSIONS:** The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge or change the reason for discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or under honorable conditions (general). I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (general).

2. My reasons for this action are:

a. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 2 Sep 01 and on or about 3 Sep 01 without authority, fail to go to your prescribed place of duty, to wit: details at building 776. For this infraction and subparagraphs "b", "c", and "d" below you received an Article 15 on 3 Oct 01.

b. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 3 Sep 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: paragraph 5.2.1, Sheppard Air Force Base Instruction 36-2902, dated 15 Oct 1997, by wrongfully failing to remain on Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas.

c. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 3 Sep 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: paragraph 5.2.2, Sheppard Air Force Base Instruction 36-2902, dated 15 Oct 1997, by wrongfully failing to remain in proper military uniform.

d. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 3 Sep 01, with intent to deceive, make to MSG [REDACTED] an official statement, to wit: you were in Phase III, which statement was totally false, and was then known by you to be so false.

e. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 7 Aug 01, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: paragraph 2.1.3, SAFBI 36-2902, dated 15 Oct 97, by wrongfully failing to keep your dormitory room in inspection order at all times. For this misconduct, you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR) on 7 Aug 01.

f. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 4 Apr 01, attempt to unlawfully enter the dorm room of Airman First Class: [REDACTED] For this misconduct you received an Article 15 on 17 May 01.

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible to reenlist in the Air Force and will be denied enlistment in any component of the armed forces. Any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.

3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Capt. [REDACTED] Area Defense Counsel, at Bldg 1638, Room 110 on 27 Nov 01 at 1400 hours. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 26 Nov 01 unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
6. You were scheduled for a medical examination on 29 Oct 01 at 0630.
7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the 364 TRS commander's support staff office.
8. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
