AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD2003-00363

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to Honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge to Honorable is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an impropriety that would justify upgrade of the discharge.


ISSUE: The Board finds that the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the board was able to identify none. The records indicated the applicant received two Articles 15. The misconduct included abuse of government credit card, and failure to pay credit card debt in a timely manner. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for misconduct – minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32, *Military Retirements and Separations*, and AFI 36-3208, *Administrative Separation of Airmen*, Chapter 5, section H, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. Between on or about 7 May 99 and on or about 25 Jul 99, you were derelict in the performance of your duties by failing to refrain from using your government credit card for personal use and for dishonorably failing to pay your debt to the sum of \$4,935.30. For this misconduct you received an Article 15 nonjudicial punishment action, dated 6 Sep 00. Punishment consisted of a suspended reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, 7 days extra duty, and a reprimand. Additionally, an Unfavorable Information File was established.
- b. Between on or about 23 Aug 00 and on or about 26 Apr 01, you dishonorably failed to pay your debt to be a second of \$4,045.69. For this misconduct, you received an Article 15 nonjudicial punishment action, dated 17 May 01. Punishment consisted of reduction to the grade of Airman.
- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Captara Area Defense Counsel, 895-9530, on 25 Jun 01, at 150 hours. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me within three days after receipt of the notification memorandum, unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 7. You must report to the Shaw AFB Hospital, Physical Examinations Section, between the hours of 1100 1300, Mon Thurs, for a medical examination.

- 8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the orderly room.
- 9. The Air Force is entitled to recoup a portion of educational assistance, special pay, or bonus monies which you received, if any, if you separate before completing the period of active duty you agreed to serve. This recoupment applies whether you voluntarily separate or are involuntarily separated. Recoupment will apply regardless of the basis for involuntary discharge, unless the reason is homosexual conduct. The recoupment in all cases is an amount that bears the same ratio to the total cost provided to you as the unserved portion of active duty bears to the total period of active duty you agreed to serve. If you dispute that you are indebted for educational assistance, a board or other authority will make findings and recommendations concerning the validity of the indebtedness.
- 10. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
