AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2003-00418

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: The Board grants the requested relief.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by applicant substantiates an impropriety that would justify a change of discharge. However, based upon the record and evidence provided by applicant, the Board finds the applicant's reason and authority for discharge inequitable.

ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15 for assault, disorderly conduct, and destruction of property. The applicant states that she hit the other member out of self-defense. Although the member waived her Administrative Board in return for a General discharge, the majority of the DRB members thought the applicant served satisfactorily during her 12 years of service.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority.

However, in view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that the overall quality of applicant's service is more accurately reflected by an Honorable discharge and the reason for the discharge is more accurately described as secretarial authority under the provisions of Title 10, USC 1553.

During the twelve years I served I experienced some very personal tragedies that affected me greatly and caused undo stress in my personal and professional life. This included physical abuse, two divorces and the death of one of my children. At the time of my discharge I was attempting to deal with the pregnancy of my teenage daughter.

I am requesting that a through (sic) review be performed on all my personnel and medical records that can substantiate everything I have indicated. I thank you very much for your consideration.

- 1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for the commission of a serious offense according to AFR 39-10, under the provisions of paragraph 5-49d. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority to support this recommendation are attached.
- 2. My reasons for this action are:
- a. In that you, did, at Plattsburgh Air Force Base, New York, on or about 12 May 90, willfully and wrongfully damage by breaking the rear window and tearing the rear seat with an unknown object, a passenger vehicle, the amount of said damage being in the sum in excess of \$100.00, the property of Technical Sergeant for which you received an Article 15 and a vacation of your NCO status, both dated 31 May 90.
- b. In that you, did, at Plattsburgh Air Force Base, New York, on or about 12 May 1990, unlawfully strike Technical Sergeant on the chest and legs with your hands and feet, for which you received an Article 15 and a vacation of your NCO status, both dated 31 May 90.
- c. In that you, were, at Plattsburgh Air Force Base, New York, on or about 12 May 1990, disorderly, for which you received an Article 15 and a vacation of your NCO status, both dated 31 May 90.
- 3. This action could result in your separation with an under other than honorable conditions discharge. I am recommending that you receive an under other than honorable conditions discharge. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will make the final decision in this matter. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.
- 4. You have the right to:
 - a. Consult legal counsel.
 - b. Present your case to an administrative discharge board.
 - c. Be represented by counsel at a board hearing.
- d. Submit statements in your own behalf in addition to, or in lieu of, the board hearing.
- e. Waive the above rights. You must consult legal counsel before making a decision to waive any of your rights.

- 5. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the 380th Strategic Hospital, at 0730 on 19 Jun 90.
- 6. Military legal counsel, Captain building 100, 7054, has been obtained to assist you. An appointment has been scheduled for you to consult him on 18 Jun 90 at 1400 in Building 100. Instead of the appointed counsel, you may have another, if the lawyer you request is in the active military service and is reasonably available as determined according to AFR 111-1. In addition to military counsel, you have the right to employ civilian counsel. The Air Force does not pay expenses incident to the employment of civilian counsel. Civilian counsel, if employed, must be readily available.
- 7. Confer with your counsel and reply, in writing, within 7 workdays, specifying the rights you choose to exercise. The statement must be signed in the presence of your counsel who also will sign it. If you waive your right to a hearing before an administrative discharge board, you may submit written statements in your own behalf. I will send the statements to the discharge authority with the case file to be considered with this recommendation. If you fail to respond, your failure will constitute a waiver of the right to the board hearing.
- 8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act Statement as explained in AFR 39-10, attachment 6. A copy of AFR 39-10 is available for your use in the orderly room.

9. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
