AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2003-00446

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable and to change the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of Discharge, change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code are denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant does not contest his discharge. He states that since his discharge he has grown and gained focus in his life with marriage and the birth of a son. He would like to reenter the Air Force. The records indicated the applicant received two Article 15s. The first for wrongfully and unlawfully making under lawful affirmation, two false statements in substance. The second one for failure to obey a lawful order to not drive his vehicle on base. In addition, he received two Letters of Reprimand and one Letter of Counseling for careless driving, being late for duty, failure to go and receiving a speeding ticket. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.


CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Misconduct--Pattern of Misconduct. The authority for my recommendation is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.50.2. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. You did, on or about 14 April 2001, drive carelessly in base housing. For this incident you received a Letter of Reprimand, dated 1 May 2001. (Atch 1-1)
- b. You did, on or about 11 May 2001, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty. For this incident you received a Letter of Counseling, dated 18 May 2001. (Atch 1-2)
- c. You did, on or about 27 June 2001, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty
- d. You did, on or about 27 June 2001, receive a speeding ticket for driving 14 miles over the posted speed limit.

For the incidents in paragraphs c and d about you received a Letter of Reprimand, dated 5 July 2001. In addition, an Unfavorable Information File (UIF) was also established. (Atch 1-3)

- e. You did, at or near Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska, on or about 17 July 2001, on an Air Force Form 1168, Statement of Suspect/Witness/Complainant, wrongfully and unlawfully make under lawful affirmation a false statement in substance as follows: "I sent the money order worth \$226.00 to the Omaha Police Department," which statement you did not then believe to be true.



For the incidents listed in paragraphs e and f above you received Nonjudicial Punishment, dated 2 August 2001, consisting of reduction to Airman, 14 days extra duty and restriction to Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska, for 14 days. In addition, this Letter of Reprimand was placed in your already existing UIF. (Atch 1-4)

- g. You, having knowledge of a lawful order issued by Master Sergeant to wit: not to drive your vehicle on base, an order which it was your duty to obey, did, at or near Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska, on or about 1 August 2001, fail to obey the same by wrongfully operating your vehicle on base. For this incident you received Nonjudicial Punishment, dated 10 August 2001, consisting of a reduction to the grade of Airman Basic. In addition, this action was placed in your already existing UIF. (Atch 1-5)
- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and probably any other branch of the military.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Captain Bldg 323C, RM 302, Phone 4-3939, at 1530 on 15 Aug 01. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 5. You have the right to submit statements on your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by <u>20 Avg 61</u> unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements on your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the 55th Medical Group, <u>fouckels Hall</u> at <u>OSOO</u> on <u>//o Akeg O/</u> for the examination. Please pick up your medical records prior to your appointment.
- 8. You have been scheduled for an initial separation appointment. You must report to the 55th Mission Support Squadron, Separations and Retirements Section, Room 235, Bldg 323C, at on home of the first of the second of the second
- 9. You have been scheduled for a pre-separation briefing. You must report to the Family Support Center at ______ on _____ for the briefing.
