AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2003-00536

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of Discharge is denied.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.


ISSUE: The applicant submitted no issues and requested that the review be completed based on the available service record. The Board reviewed the entire record and found no evidence of impropriety or inequity in this case on which to base an upgrade of discharge. The records indicated applicant received three Article 15s and one Letter of Reprimand for misconduct. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the disciplinary infractions were a significant departure from the conduct expected of all military members. The Board found no evidence of impropriety or inequity in this case on which to base an upgrade of discharge.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for a pattern of misconduct, specifically, conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline. The authority for my recommendation is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, Chapter 5, section H, paragraph 5.50.2. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending your service be characterized as general.

2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On 20 and 21 February 1994, you wrongfully transported alcoholic beverages into your training center dormitory at Lowry Air Force Base, CO contrary to your duty and training center regulation. You received Nonjudicial Punishment under Article 15 dated 3 Mar 94 for this misconduct. (atch 1a)
- b. On 6 Aug 94 you failed to stop for a traffic light on base at Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, NC. You received a traffic ticket for this offense dated 6 August 1994 (atch 1b)
- c. On 17 September 1994, you operated a vehicle on Seymour Johnson Air Force Base while drunk. For this misconduct you received Nonjudicial Punishment under Article 15 dated 12 Oct 94. (atch 1c)
- d. On 27 Dec 94, you illegally entered Seymour Johnson Air Force Base. For this infraction, you received a Letter of Reprimand dated 12 Jan 95. It entered an Unfavorable Information File on 15 Jan 95. (atch 1d)

- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. - 7. You were previously scheduled for a mandatory medical examination, at the Physical Examination Section, 4th Medical Group, Seymour Johnson AFB, at <u>Off</u> hours on <u>Inter</u> and at <u>hiso</u> hours on <u>factor</u> hours on <u>factor</u>.
- 8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in your Orderly Room.
