AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2003-00537

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of Discharge is denied.

ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received two Article 15s, and one Letter of Reprimand for failure to support his family, failure to go and wrongfully using his government credit card. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate. Applicant states that his discharge did not take into account the good things he did while in the service. The DRB took note of the applicant's duty performance as documented by his performance reports, letters of recommendation and other accomplishments. They found the seriousness of the willful misconduct offset any positive aspects of the applicant's duty performance. The Board concluded the discharge was appropriate for the reasons which were the basis for this case.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.





SUBJECT: Letter of Notification

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for misconduct consisting of minor disciplinary infractions, according to AFI 36-3208, under the provisions of paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

2. My reason for the action is your engagement in misconduct consisting of minor disciplinary infractions. Specifically:

a. You did, on or about 26 November 1996, violate a lawful general regulation, to wit: paragraph 25-1, Air Force Instruction 65-104, by wrongfully using a Government authorized American Express card in the amount less than \$50.00 for other than official travel (Atch 1-1).

b. You did, on or about 12 December 1996, make and utter to the Tyndall Air Force Exchange, Tyndall Air Force Base, Florida, a certain check, in the amount of \$50.40, and did thereafter fail to maintain sufficient funds in your account for payment of such check in full upon its presentation for payment (Atch 1-1).

c. You did, on or about 12 December 1996, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty, to wit: **Example 1996**, and **Compared Weights**, Panama City, Florida, for a final inspection you had scheduled (Atch 1-2).

d. You did, on or about 18 December 1996, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty, to wit: **Character Prescribed** (Atch 1-2).

e. You did, between on or about 1 June 1996 and on or about 27 January 1997, fail to support your dependents, as evidenced by a Letter of Reprimand dated 28 January 1997 (Atch 1-3).

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of the recommendation are attached. The Commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for re-enlistment in the Air Force.

6. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the NCOIC, physical examinations, building 1309 on <u>1 APR 97</u> at <u>1345</u> hours.

7. You have been scheduled for a preliminary appointment with the 325 MSS Relocations Section. You must report to building 662, room 216 on <u>2APR 97</u> at <u>0900</u> hours.

8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the orderly room.
