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AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of Discharge and change of reenlistment code is denied.

ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15 for failure to go and failed the alcohol abuse treatment program. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change her negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for failure in the Alcohol Abuse Treatment Program. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, 5.32. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general (under honorable conditions).

2. My reason for this action is as follows:

You did, on or about 1 Dec 98, at MacDill Air Force Base, Florida, fail to satisfactorily complete the Substance Abuse Control Program by disregarding the program's mandated alcohol abstinence policy. This incident was recorded on Standard Form 600, Chronological Record of Medical Care, dated 1 Dec 98 and a Memorandum from Control of Control of Control Program Manager, dated 9 Dec 98.

3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising Special Court Martial (SPCM) jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.
