### AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00076

**GENERAL:** The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable and to change the reason and authority for the discharge.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of Discharge and change of reason and authority for discharge are denied.


ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15, three Letters of Reprimand, one Letter of Counseling, and a Vacation action under the UCMJ for various misconduct, including assault. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate. If he can provide additional documented information to substantiate an issue, the applicant should consider exercising his right to make a personal appearance before the Board. If he should choose to exercise his right to a personal appearance hearing, the applicant should be prepared to provide the DRB with factual evidence of the inequity and any exemplary post-service accomplishments as well as any contributions to the community.

**CONCLUSIONS:** The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for pattern of misconduct, involving minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.


### 2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On or about 22 Sep 96, you wrongfully consumed alcohol while under the state legal drinking age of 21. For your actions, you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR) dated 24 Sep 96.
- b. On or about 6 Aug 96, you assaulted Amn during a physical altercation in your room at the Washington dormitory, Ellsworth AFB, South Dakota, to wit; you put a knife to the victim's throat. For your actions, you received a LOR dated 16 Sep 96. This LOR was placed in your Unfavorable Information File (UIF).
- c. On or about 29 Jul 96, while under suspended punishment, you without authority, failed to go to your appointed place of duty. For your actions, that portion of your punishment that extended to suspended reduction to Airman Basic was vacated on 7 Aug 96.
- d. On or about 11 Jun 96, you failed to report to work on time. For your actions, you received an Article 15 dated 2 Jul 96. This Article 15 was placed in your UIF.
- e. On 22 May 96, you failed to report to work on time. For your actions, you received a LOR dated 29 May 96.
- f. On 15 May 96, you were placed on quarters by Captain. You failed to stay in your quarters and went downtown. For your actions, you received a Letter of Counseling dated 20 May 96.
- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force, and if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Captara Area Defense Counsel, 5-2158, Bldg 2405 on 30 Sep 96 at 0830 hrs. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.

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- 5. You have the right to submit statements on your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 3 Oct 96, unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the Physical Exams Section of the Base Hospital at 0715 hrs on 1 Oct 96 for the examination. This is a mandatory appointment, and you must be in uniform. For the examination, fast for 14 hours prior to the examination, if you wear glasses, bring them, and if you wear contacts, remove them 24 hours prior to the examination.
- 8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in your orderly room.
- 9. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
