AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00088

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable, to change the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge, change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code are denied.

ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received two Articles 15, three Letters of Reprimand, three Letters of Counseling, four traffic tickets, and a Vacation action under the UCMJ for various acts of misconduct outlined in the examiners brief. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

- 1. I am recommending you be discharged from the United States Air Force for a Pattern of Misconduct, Conduct Prejudicial to Good Order and Discipline. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32, *Military Retirements and Separations*, and AFI 36-3208, *Administrative Separation of Airmen*, Section 5H, paragraph 5.50.2. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or under honorable conditions (General). I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (General).
- 2. My reasons for this action are based on the following:
- a. You were, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 27 May 2003, derelict in the performance of your duties in that you willfully failed to refrain from using your Bank of America government travel card while not on temporary duty or permanent change of station duty status. For this act of misconduct, you received a second Record of Nonjudicial Punishment Proceeding (Article 15), dated 7 July 2003. This was added to your existing Unfavorable Information File (UIF). (Attachment A.)
- b. You did, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 13 June 2003, willfully fail to obey lawful orders when you failed to put on your battle dress uniform blouse as directed in anticipation of leaving the work area, and when you refused to promptly identify the time of a pending medical appointment when directed to immediately do so. For these acts of misconduct, you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR), dated 20 June 2003. (Attachment B.)
- c. You did, at or near Base Z, from on or about 1 March 2003 to on or about 8 May 2003, willfully fail to obey a standing order restricting you from operating any motor vehicle on military installations when you operated a shuttle bus. In addition, you were derelict in the performance of your duties in that you did not identify to your deployed chain of command that you are subject to this standing order. For this act of misconduct, you received an LOR, dated 18 June 2003. (Attachment C.)
- d. You did, at or near the continental United States, and at or near Base Z, from on or about 15 January 2003 to on or about 2 April 2003, dishonorably fail to pay a just debt in the sum of \$390.00 to Payday Express Grand Forks. For this act of misconduct, you received a Record of Proceedings of Vacation of Suspended Nonjudicial Punishment, dated 8 April 2003. (Attachment D.)

- e. You were, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 26 August 2002, derelict in the performance of your duties in that you willfully failed to refrain from consuming alcoholic beverages while under the legal age of 21. You also were, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 26 August 2002, derelict in the performance of your duties in that you willfully failed to refrain from driving a vehicle while your license was suspended. For these acts of misconduct, you received a second Record of Nonjudicial Punishment Proceeding (Article 15), dated 4 October 2002. A UIF was established on 8 October 2002, and the Article 15 was placed in the UIF. (Attachment E.)
- f. You were, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 31 August 2001, derelict in the performance of your duties in that you operated a forklift in an unsafe and reckless manner. For this act of misconduct, you received Record of Individual Counseling (RIC), dated 5 September 2001. (Attachment F.)
- g. You did, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 17 August 2001, willfully fail to obey a lawful order to study your Career Development Course (CDC) from 1200 to 1630 hours in preparation for your upcoming CDC end-of-course test. In addition, you left early for the day, without notifying the designated person in charge that you were leaving. For these acts of misconduct, you received a RIC, dated 21 September 2001 (should be 21 August 2001). (Attachment G.)
- h. You were, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 7 July 2001, derelict in the performance of your duties in that you willfully failed to wear your seatbelt while operating a vehicle, as prescribed by state law and Air Force Instruction 91-207. You also exceeded the speed limit while doing so. For these acts of misconduct, you received a RIC, dated 20 July 2012 (should be 12 July 2001). (Attachment H.)
- i. You did, at or near Grand Forks Air Force Base, North Dakota, on or about 21 February 2001, willfully damage government property by punching the walls of Dorm 217 with your fist. For this act of misconduct, you received an LOR, dated 26 February 2001. (Attachment I.)
- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force, and if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. You have been scheduled an appointment at the Office of the Area Defense Counsel at Building 255 on ______ at _____ at _____ hours. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statement you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 30 Tol 03 at 0906 hours unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

- 8. Deliver to me immediately your military identification card. I have requested that temporary identification card(s) be issued IAW AFI 36-3026(I), paragraph 4.2. You will report to me by COB __2550/_____, to verify that issuance of temporary identification cards has been accomplished.
- 9. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A Privacy Act statement is attached. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the squadron orderly room.
