AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00110

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge. The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.


ISSUE: The applicant submitted no issues and requested that the review be completed based on the available service record. The Board reviewed the entire record and found no evidence of impropriety or inequity in this case on which to base an upgrade of discharge. The records indicated applicant received an Article 15, a Vacation action under the UCMJ, and a Record of Individual Counseling. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative/repetitive behavior. The Board concluded the disciplinary infractions were a significant departure from the conduct expected of all military members.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Letter of Notification

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for a pattern of misconduct consisting of conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, Section H, Paragraph 5.50.2. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as either honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

2. My reasons for this action are:

You did, at Langley Air Force Base, Virginia, on or about 25 April 1995, violate a lawful general regulation, to wit: paragraph 1.12, Air Force Instruction 34-119, dated 25 July 1995, by wrongfully possessing alcohol while under the age of twenty-one. (Atch 1)

You did, at Langley Air Force Base, Virginia, on or about 21 April 1995, violate a lawful general regulation, to wit: paragraph 2-1(b), Air Force Regulation 125-14, dated 8 July, by wrongfully driving a motor vehicle on Langley Air Force Base while your driver's license was suspended. (Atch 1)

You did, at Langley Air Force Base, Virginia, on or about 21 April 1995, violate a lawful general regulation, to wit: paragraph 2-1 (a)(1), Air Force Regulation 125-14, dated 8 July 1988, by wrongfully driving your motor vehicle approximately 27 miles per hour in a posted 15 miles per hour zone. (Atch 1)

You, who should have known of your duties at Langley Air Force Base, Virginia, on or about 25 April 1995, were derelict in the performance of those duties in that you willfully possessed a three foot snake in your dormitory room, as it was your duty not to do. (Atch 1)

You were, in Hampton, Virginia, on or about 19 November 1994, found drunk on the side of a road on Hampton University and were unable to return yourself to Langley Air Force Base, which conduct was of a nature to bring discredit upon the armed forces.

Copies of the documents to support this recommendation are attached and will be forwarded to the separation authority. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.

- 3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Captain Area Defense Counsel, 56 Willow Street, Suite 101, Ext 5607 at <u>0900</u> hours on <u>5 June 1995</u>. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 60000 1995 unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 6. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the 1st Medical Group, Physical Exam Section at <u>0745</u> hours on <u>6 June 1995</u> and at <u>1400</u> hours on <u>6 June 1995</u> for the examination.
- 7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act Statement as explained in AFI 36-3208, Attachment 2. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the unit orderly room.
- 8. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
