### AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00125

**GENERAL:** The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

**FINDINGS**: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant was discharged for conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline. The records indicated the applicant received two Articles 15, a Letter of Reprimand, four Records of Individual Counseling, and six verbal counselings for misconduct. His infractions included being late to work, dereliction of duty, unsatisfactory performance, missing an appointment, civilian arrest for disorderly conduct and underage drinking, on-base underage possession of alcohol, and providing alcohol to other underage individuals. He also was found driving on an invalid license, speeding, driving on an expired registration, and cited for unsafe vehicle operation. Member was sent to alcohol rehabilitation evaluation and counseling after two of his three alcohol-related incidents, and was diagnosed a problem drinker. He was also permanently decertified from the Permanent Reliability Program and had a referral "2" Enlisted Performance Report that documented his lack of attention to supervisory instruction, disregard for safety practices and tech order data, and regression in upgrade training. The DRB opined that through these extensive unit administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior and was unwilling or unable to do so. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.


**CONCLUSIONS:** The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for misconduct, specifically, conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline. The authority for this action is AFR 39-10, paragraph 5-47b. If my recommendation is approved, your discharge will be characterized as general or honorable. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

## 2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On or about 13 Jun 91, you were late for duty. For this offense, you received a letter of counseling on 13 Jun 91.
- b. On or about 11 Jan 92, you attempted to take a beer glass out of the NCO Club. You also had gained entry into the club with an invalid club card. For this offense, you were counseled.
- c. On or about 13 Mar 92, you possessed an alcoholic beverage while you were under age 21 years. For this offense, you received nonjudicial punishment on 2 Apr 92, including forfeiture of \$50 pay per month for one month and 30 days extra duty.
- d. On or about 28 Mar 92, you were disorderly in public. For this offense, you were convicted in the Ward County Court of disorderly conduct and ordered to pay a \$50 fine.
- e. On or about 24 Jul 92, you deviated from a technical order during an engine installation after being specifically told to follow technical order procedures. Also, you misused tools. For these offenses you received a letter of counseling on 27 Jul 92.
- f. On or about 8 Sep 92, you failed to go to a dental appointment you made for yourself. For this offense, you received a letter of counseling on 9 Sep 92.
- g. On or about 21 Sep 92, you failed to maintain required proficiency in daily tasks and because you lacked initiative. For this you were counseled on 21 Sep 92 and you were decertified on starter build up and installation.
- h. On or about 21 Feb 93, you were derelict in the performance of your duty when you provided alcoholic beverages to persons under age 21. For this offense, you received nonjudicial punishment on 18 mar 93, including reduction to Airman and suspended forfeitures of \$150.00 for two months.

- 7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act Statement as explained in AFR 39-10, attachment 2. A copy of AFR 39-10 is available for your use in the Orderly Room.
