AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00216

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUES:

Issue 1. Applicant was discharged for discreditable involvement with military or civilian authorities. The records indicated the applicant received two Articles 15, five Letters of Reprimand, three Records of Individual Counseling and two Memorandums for Record for misconduct. Her infractions included multiple missed appointments and failures to go, multiple incidents of dereliction of duty, and financial irresponsibility. Additionally, she had 1 month and 4 days lost time due to civilian incarceration for off-base offenses. The DRB opined that through these extensive administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change her negative behavior and was unwilling or unable to do so. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members and the characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was appropriate.

Issue 2. The applicant cited her desire to receive the G.I. Bill benefits as justification for upgrade. The DRB noted that when the applicant applied for these benefits, she signed a statement (DD Form 2366, on April 9, 1995) that she understood she must receive an Honorable discharge to receive future educational entitlements. The Board was sympathetic to the impact the loss of these benefits was having on the applicant, but this is not a matter of inequity or impropriety which would warrant an upgrade.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for a pattern of misconduct — discreditable involvement with military or civil authorities. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, chapter 5, section H, paragraph 5.50.1. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On or about 8 Nov 95, you, without authority, absented yourself from your unit and remained so absent until on or about 9 Nov 95. Based on your misconduct, you received Article 15 nonjudicial punishment action, dated 5 Dec 95.
- b. On or about 6 Dec 95, you failed to be at your appointed place of duty at the time prescribed, as evidenced by memorandum, dated 28 Dec 95. You were counseled for this offense.
- c. On or about 8 Jan 96, you failed to be at your appointed place of duty at the time prescribed, for which you received a letter of counseling, dated 18 Jan 96.
- d. On or about 18 Jan 96, you failed to be at your appointed place of duty at the time prescribed, for which you received a letter of counseling, dated 18 Jan 96.

The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction, or a higher authority, will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. As you are in prison at the time of the service of this memorandum, arrangements have been made for you to consult the real Defense Counsel, by telephone. His telephone number is You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me within three days after receipt of the notification memorandum, unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 7. You completed all medical examination requirements on 10 Oct 96.
- 8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the orderly room.
- 9. In accordance with AFI 36-3001, you must relinquish all identification cards within three duty days of receipt of this notification memorandum.
