# AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00224

**GENERAL:** The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

**FINDINGS**: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant was discharged for misconduct, minor disciplinary infractions. He had an Article 15, a vacation of suspended punishment, and a Letter of Counseling. His misconduct included making a false official statement, leaving the scene of an on-base accident, and three separate incidents of disrespect to noncommissioned officers. At the time of the discharge, member consulted counsel and waived his right to submit a statement in his own behalf. Applicant now contends he was getting into trouble as a result of other personal problems he was experiencing. While it is understandable that a member experiencing personal problems has additional stress, member has not provided sufficient evidence as to what his problems or resultant stressors were or how they were unique. Furthermore, there is little evidence he sought help from available agencies such as the Chaplain, family support center, life skills clinic, or his chain of command. In view of the unit's administrative actions, member had ample opportunity to come within expected standards of conduct. But he was either unable or unwilling to correct his behavior. The Board could not find any mitigation or extenuation to warrant an upgrade, and the records review disclosed no inequity or impropriety.

**CONCLUSIONS:** The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

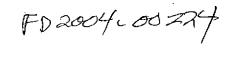

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32, *Military Retirements and Separations*, and AFI 36-3208, *Administrative Separation of Airmen*, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your discharge will be described as under honorable conditions (General) and you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.

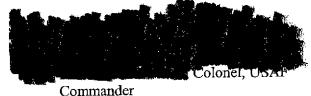
# 2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On or about 7 Jan 03, you were disrespectful to an NCO when you continually interrupted her while she was talking and you displayed a disrespectful tone and demeanor. For this incident you received a Letter of Counseling (LOC), dated 7 Jan 03.
- b. On or about 7 Jan 03, you were disrespectful in language toward an NCO. On or about 22 Jan 03 you made a false official statement, and you left the scene of an accident. For these incidents you were given an Article 15, with a punishment of reduction in grade to Airman, forfeiture of \$100.00 pay for 2 month (suspended), and 30 days extra duty, dated 21 Feb 03. This Article 15 established your Unfavorable Information File (UIF).
- c. On or about 25 Jun 03, you were disrespectful in language to an NCO for which the suspended portion of the Article 15 punishment was vacated on 18 Jul 03. This action was added to your UIF.
- 3. Copies of the documents to support this recommendation are attached and will be forwarded to the separation authority. The separation authority will make the findings and recommendations required under 10 U.S.C. 2005(g) regarding recoupment of education assistance funds, if applicable. The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult the Area Defense Counsel, 54 Willow Street, Bldg. 147, at 6900 hours on 8 AUGUST 2003. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 1630 hours on 12 AUGUST 2003

unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

- 6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the 1st Medical Group, Physical Exam Section at 0945 hours on 11 AUGUST 2003 and an additional examination will be scheduled if necessary.
- 8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the unit orderly room.
- 9. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
