AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00322

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant appeared before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) at Washington D.C., via video teleconference from Randolph AFB, Texas.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge. Despite numerous efforts by the DRB during the applicant's personal appearance to have him articulate issues of impropriety or inequity in his administrative discharge, he was unable to do so. In fact, he admitted during questioning by the DRB that there were no inequities or improprieties in the handling of his involuntary separation from active duty. Therefore, the DRB finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety which would justify a change of discharge.

CONCLUSIONS: The DRB concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation, was within the discretion of the discharge authority, and that the applicant was provided substantial administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings, the DRB further concludes there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge. Thus, the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

- 1. I am recommending you receive a general discharge from the United States Air Force under AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.54, for drug abuse. If this discharge action is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general.
- 2. My reasons for this action are: You did, at or near Ogden, Utah, between on or about 10 Jan 03 and on or about 11 Jan 03, wrongfully use methamphetamine. For this misconduct, you were convicted by a special court-martial on 24 Jun 03, and sentenced to 3 months confinement, reduction to Airman Basic, and forfeiture of \$767.00 pay per month for 3 months. (Atch 1a)
- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The Special Court Martial Convening Authority or a higher authority will determine whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult with the Circuit Defense Counsel on 10 Sep 03 at 1100 hours. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 12 Sep 03, unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 7. You are required to attend a separation medical examination. Your First Sergeant will contact Force Health Management at 775-4514 to schedule an appointment.
