# AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

CASE NUMBER

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable and to change the reason and

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge. FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge and change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of

reenlistment code are denied.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.

Applicant contends that she would like her discharge upgraded so that she may re-enter the military. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15, one Letter of Reprimand, three Records of Individual Counseling and four tickets for misconduct which included drinking alcohol while under age, dereliction of duty, disrespect to a superior, missing appointments, and traffic infractions. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change her negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all ISSUE: The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be military members.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process. appropriate.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

- 1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The authority for this action is AFR 39-10, paragraph 5-46. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.
- 2. My reasons for this action are:
- a. Traffic Ticket (13 Oct 88): You received a citation for parking in a prohibited area. For this offense you were counseled by the First Sergeant. (Attachment 1.1)
- b. Failure to Go (24 Jan 89): You failed to go to a scheduled dental appointment. For this offense you were counseled by your supervisor. (Attachment 1.2)
- c. Traffic Ticket (27 Feb 89): You received a citation for speeding. For this offense you were counseled by the First Sergeant. (Attachment 1.3)
- d. Traffic Ticket (28 Feb 89): You received a citation for not having base registration decals on your vehicle. For this offense you were counseled by the First Sergeant. (Attachment 1.4)
- e. Failure to Safeguard Line Badge (6 Jun 89): You received a Record of Individual Counseling for a repeated incident of not safeguarding your line badge. (Attachment 1.5)
- f. Dishonored Check (6 Dec 89): You made and uttered a worthless check to the first the amount of \$900.00, and did thereafter dishonorably fail to maintain sufficient funds in the Edwards Air Force Base Federal Credit Union for payment of this check in full when presented for payment. For this offense you received a Letter of Admonition from the Squadron Section Commander and were entered into the Personal Financial Management Program (PFMP). (Attachment 1.6)
- g. Traffic Ticket (2 Feb 90): You received a citation for speeding. For this offense you were counseled by the Squadron Section Commander. (Attachment 1.7)
- h. Failure to Go (5 Feb 90): You failed to go to a scheduled medical appointment. For this offense you received a Record of Counseling from

your supervisor. (Attachment 1.8)

- i. Dereliction of Duty (26 Apr 90)/Disobey Lawful Order (27 Apr 90)/Disrespect to Superior Noncommissioned Officer (27 Apr 90): You were derelict in the performance of your duties in that you were directed to bring specific documents with you to your PFMP appointment, which you later canceled because you did not have your paperwork. You disobeyed your supervisor's direct order, to wit: bringing in said paperwork for safe-keeping to ensure readiness for the rescheduled appointment. You were disrespectful to your Branch Superintendent, then known by you to be your superior Noncommissioned Officer, when confronted with your rationale for not obeying said order. For these offenses you received a Letter of Reprimand from the Commander. (Attachment 1.9)
- j. Delinquent Layaway Account (21 May 90): You were delinquent in paying on your home layaway plan. For this offense you were counseled by the Squadron Section Commander. (Attachment 1.10)
- k. Disobey Lawful General Regulation (2 Oct 90 and 11 Oct 90): You failed to obey AFR 215-7 in that you consumed alcoholic beverages while under the age of 21 years. For these offenses you were punished under the provisions of Article 15 of the UCMJ. (Attachment 1.11)

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The Commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.

- 4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 3 Dec 90\_ unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 6. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to Bldg 3925 at 0900 Hrs on 28 Nov 90 for the examination.
- 7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act Statement as explained in AFR 39-10, attachment 6. A copy of AFR 39-10 is available for your use by requesting it from the First Sergeant.
