AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00379

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: The Board grants the requested relief.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by applicant substantiates an impropriety that would justify a change of discharge. However, based upon the record and evidence provided by applicant, the Board finds the applicant's discharge and reason and authority for discharge inequitable.


ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15 for inhaling the fumes of liquid butane. The Board found the applicant's explanation plausible and opined that he does not fit the "true" definition of drug abuser. Although inhaling liquid butane is still misconduct, the Board agreed that the characterization of the applicant's discharge should be changed to Honorable and the Reason and Authority changed to Misconduct – Minor Disciplinary Infractions.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

However, in view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that the overall quality of applicant's service is more accurately reflected by an Honorable discharge and the reason for the discharge is more accurately described as Misconduct – Minor Disciplinarily Infractions under the provisions of Title 10, USC 1553.


