AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00383

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE:

Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15 for misconduct. The misconduct included wrongfully using marijuana on two separate occasions. The Board noted that the applicant signed a statement (Air Force Form 2030, USAF Drug and Alcohol Abuse Certificate, dated Jan 16, 2003) that she understood that drug or alcohol abuse was not compatible with the Air Force and would not be tolerated. It also stated that she might be disciplined and possibly discharged for drug or alcohol offenses. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Misconduct: Drug Abuse. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.54. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as an Under Honorable Conditions (General) Discharge. I am recommending that your service be characterized as an Under Honorable Conditions (General) Discharge.

2. My reason for this action is:

a. Between on or about 1 Nov 03 and on or about 1 Dec 03, you wrongfully used marijuana. For this drug abuse, you received an Article 15, dated 1 Mar 04. Your punishment included reduction in grade to E-1 and a reprimand. An Unfavorable Information File (UIF) was established.

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the United States Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment. The separation authority will make the findings and recommendations required under 10 U.S.C. Section 2005(g).

- 3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult on 11 May ou, at 0830 hours. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 1400 16 Mar 04 unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 6. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to 56th Medical Group

Hospital, 7219 N. Litchfield Rd. on It Mar 04, at 0730 hours for the examination.
