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AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2004-00441

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for a change to the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change in the reason and authority for the discharge or to change the RE Code.

ISSUE: Applicant does not contest the discharge. He simply states that he would like to reenter the military. The records indicated the applicant received an Honorable discharge. The reason for discharge was for his Failure in the Alcohol Abuse Treatment Program. The DRB opined that through this program, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior; however, he continued to drink which resulted in failure of the program. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Failure in Alcohol Abuse Treatment. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.32.1.2. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as honorable.

2. My reasons for this discharge action are as follows:

a. On 26 November 1996, a Treatment Committee determined that you had failed to progress in the Substance Abuse Program Track 4a, outpatient treatment, due to your failure to maintain abstinence as required, failure to set and meet specific goals of rehabilitation, and having little or no personal commitment toward treatment, including poor motivation. (Atch 1.1, 1.2 and 1.3)

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.

3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. For an appointment to consult the Area Defense Counsel (Capter bldg 937), please contact him at the You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.

4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by <u>IDDO</u> hours on <u>17 pec 96</u> (3 workdays) unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
