GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable, change the reason and authority for the discharge, and change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge, change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code are denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received five. Letters of Reprimand, one Letter of Counseling, and one Record of Individual Counseling, all in just eight months of service, for failure to go, dereliction of duty, failure to shave, bringing a cell phone to class, failure to keep his room in inspection order and for bringing alcohol into the dormitory while in Phase III. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or under honorable conditions (general). I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (general).

f. You, who knew or should have known of your duties at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 11 Sep 04, were derelict in the performance of those duties in that you failed to refrain from bringing alcohol into the dormitory while in phase III, as it was your duty to do. For this misconduct, you received an LOR on 16 Sep 04.

g. You did, at or near Keesler AFB MS, on or about 17 Aug 04, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty, to wit: the outprocessing pay briefing. For this misconduct, you received an AF Form 174, Record of Individual Counseling, on 17 Aug 04.

h. You, who knew or should have known of your duties at or near Keesler AFB MS, on or about 4 Aug 04, were derelict in the performance of those duties in that you failed to shave or attain a shaving waiver, as it was your duty to do. For this misconduct, you received an LOR on 6 Aug 04.

i. You, who knew or should have known of your duties at or near Keesler AFB MS, on or about 12 Jul 04, were derelict in the performance of those duties in that you failed to refrain from bringing a cell phone to class, as it was your duty to do. For this misconduct and subparagraph "j" below, you received a Letter of Counseling (LOC) on 13 Jul 04.

j. You, who knew or should have known of your duties at or near Keesler AFB MS, on or about 8 Jul 04, were derelict in the performance of those duties in that you failed to keep your room in inspection order at all times, as it was your duty to do.

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and will probably be denied enlistment in any component of the armed forces.

5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
