AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2005-00231

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant appeared and testified before the Discharge Review Board (DRB), without counsel, at Andrews AFB on 20 Oct 2005.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: The Board grants the requested relief. The discharge is upgraded to Honorable.

ISSUE: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received a General (Under Honorable Conditions) discharge from the West Virginia Air National Guard on 8 Jan 2005 for misconduct – drug abuse. The applicant tested positive for marijuana during a UTA weekend in 2004. The Board found that the member has had an exemplary 28 satisfactory years of service for retirement. One year and eight months of that time he served on active duty. During that time, the applicant served 10 months in Vietnam as an Army Infantryman. He also received the Bronze Star and two Purple Hearts (unconfirmed). The applicant stated that the misconduct was the only blemish in an otherwise outstanding military career and that he was truly sorry for his indiscretion. The Board concluded that relief is warranted based upon consideration of the applicant's service record. However, the Board did not condone the misconduct.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

However, in view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that the overall quality of applicant's service is more accurately reflected by an Honorable discharge.




