AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2005-00307

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable, to change the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge, change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code are denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: The applicant would like to have his reenlistment eligibility code changed so that he may re-enter the military and serve his country. The records indicated the applicant received two Article 15s, four Letters of Reprimand, and one Record of Individual Counseling for misconduct. The misconduct included failure to go on divers occasions, unlawfully entering a dorm room of another military member, financial irresponsibility, failure to repair, lack of initiative, and leaving his appointed place of duty without authorization. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded there were not any inequities or improprieties discovered that would support his request to change his reenlistment eligibility code.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

- 1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for misconduct; specifically, minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFR 39-10, paragraph 5-46. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

- g. On 8 Jul 91, you left your appointed place of duty to get an ID card, but failed to do so. Furthermore, on 9 Jul 91, you failed to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty. For such misconduct, you received a UIF Letter of Reprimand, dated 12 Jul 91.

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached.
