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AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2005-00327

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE:

The record indicated the applicant received an Article 15 for misconduct. The Article 15 was administered for wrongful use of a controlled substance; mushrooms containing psilocin, a Schedule I controlled substance. As a result, applicant was reduced to airman basic and received a reprimand. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

The DRB was pleased to see that the applicant was doing well. However, no inequity or impropriety in his discharge was suggested or found in the course of the hearing. The Board concluded the misconduct of the applicant appropriately characterized his term of service.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. 1 am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Drug Abuse. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.54. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as either honorable or under honorable conditions (general). I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (general).

2. My reasons for this action are: An investigation has revealed that on or about 24 July 2003, you conspired with two other Air Force members to wrongfully use mushrooms containing psilocin, a Schedule I controlled substance. On or about 6 August 2003, you used said mushrooms containing psilocin. For this misconduct, you were punished under Art. 15, UCMJ, on 26 March 2004 (Attachment 1).

3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.

-i. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Capt of the Ramstein AB ADC Office, DSN 480-2182, at 1300 hours, on Thursday, 15 April 2004, via a telephone consultation. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.

5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by the close of business, Monday, 19 April 2004, unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.


6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
