#### AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2005-00338

**GENERAL:** The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable and to change the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

**FINDINGS**: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

**ISSUE**: Applicant contends discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received two Articles 15, one Vacation Action, two Letters of Reprimand, and one Record of Individual Counseling. The misconduct included financial irresponsibility on numerous occasions, failure to report for squadron detail, departed duty section without authority, failure to go and making a false and fraudulent Lodging claim against the United States in the amount of \$1300.00 and in the amount of \$330.00. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

**CONCLUSIONS:** The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for misconduct, to wit: minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFR 39-10, paragraph 5-46. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general.

#### 2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On or about 4 September 1990, you made a claim against the United States in the amount of \$330.00 for lodging expenses, which claim was false and fraudulent and was then known by you to be false and fraudulent, as evidenced by AF Form 3070 dated 21 December 1990 with attachments.
- b. On or about 23 May 1990, you made a claim against the United States in the amount of \$1,300.00 for lodging expenses, which claim was false and fraudulent and was then known by you to be false and fraudulent, as evidenced by AF Form 3070 dated 21 December 1990 with attachments.
- c. On or about 21 May 1990, you did, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty, to wit: Bldg 531, as evidenced by AF Form 3070 dated 27 September 1990.
- d. Your financial irresponsibility on or about 15 August 1990 when your wife wrote a check in the amount of \$15.00 at the Base Exchange which was returned due to insufficient funds, as evidenced by Dishonored Check Notification dated 4 September 1990.
- e.'Your financial irresponsibility during the past eight months, specifically, February and March 1990 when you failed to pay just debts and in June and August 1990 when you wrote checks which were returned due to insufficient funds, as evidenced by Letter of Reprimand dated 23 August 1990 with attachment.
- f. On or about 9 July 1990, you wrote TSgt a check in the amount of \$6.00 which he cashed on the 20th of July 1990. He received the check back uncashed due to insufficient funds. You were then notified by TSgt about the returned check and you assured him that you would take care of the check on 15 August 1990. As of 20 August 1990, you still had not contacted TSgt on that matter, as evidenced by a letter from TSgt Fischbach dated 20 August 1990 with attachments.

- g. On or abut 4 June 1990 you failed to show up for a squadron cleanup detail and on or about 5 June 1990 you left for the day before being released from your detail, as evidenced by Letter of Counseling dated 5 June 1990.
- h. Your financial irresponsibility on or about 21 February 1990 when you wrote a check in the amount of \$100.00 to 1Lt Scott F. Kinsey which was returned due to insufficient funds, as evidenced by a letter from 1Lt Scott F. Kinsey dated 27 March 1990 with attachments.
- i. Your financial irresponsibility on or about 22 February 1990 when we received notice from Shifrin Willens Jewelers that you were \$200.00 past due in payment to your open charge account with a current balance of \$567.43, as evidenced by a letter from Shifrin Millens Jewelers dated 22 February 1990 with attachment.
- j. On or about 6 September 1989 you were issued an Armed Forces Traffic Ticket for speeding 31 mph in a 20 mph zone, as evidenced by DD Form 1408 dated 6 September 1989.
- k. Your financial irresponsibility when you wrote, failed to take care of a check written at MWR Supply in the amount of \$16.50 which had been returned due to insufficient funds, as evidenced by Returned Check Letter dated 19 June 1989.

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.

- 3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Capt Drew, the Area Defense Counsel, at building 708, room 323, on 2 January 1991 at 0900 hours. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by \_\_\_\_\_\_ January 1991 unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 6. You were scheduled for a medical examination. You were ordered to report to the 410th Strategic Hospital, physical examination section, at 0000 hrs on 1 October 1990.

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- 7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act Statement as explained in AFR 39-10, attachment 6. A copy of AFR 39-10 is available for your use in the 410th CES Orderly Room.
- 8. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
