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#### AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2005-00350

**GENERAL:** The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable, to change the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge, change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code are denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant would like to have his discharge upgraded due to his excellent post service history. The records indicated the applicant received three Article 15s, three Letters of Reprimand, one Record of Individual Counseling and two Memorandums for Record for misconduct. The misconduct included failure to go on divers occasions, drunk and disorderly, dereliction of duty, failure to report on time, financial irresponsibility, drunk on duty, and failure to go. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board was pleased to see that the applicant was doing well and has a good job with the United States Army in the Personnel Security Field. However, no inequity or impropriety in his discharge was suggested or found in the course of the hearing. The Board concluded the misconduct of the applicant appropriately characterized his term of service.

**CONCLUSIONS:** The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as either honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as general (under honorable conditions).

## 2. My reasons for this action are:

- a. On or about 14 August 2002, without authority, you failed to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty. For this incident you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR) dated 21 August 2002 (Atch 1a). This document was placed in your existing Unfavorable Information File (UIF) (Atch 1h). Additionally, you received a vacation to your previously suspended punishment dated 3 September 2002 (Atch 1b).
- b. On or about 24 June 2002, you were drunk and disorderly. For this incident you received nonjudicial punishment dated 5 August 2002. This document was placed in your existing UIF. (Atch 1c & h).
- c. On or about 12 and 17 April 2001, you were derelict in the performance of your duties in that you willfully failed to use the prescribed technical order(s) while servicing an aircraft. For this incident you received nonjudicial punishment dated 9 May 2001. This document was placed in your existing UIF (Atch 1d & h).
- d. On or about 16 April 2001, you failed to report for work at the appointed place and time. For this incident you received an LOR dated 19 April 2001. This document was placed in your existing UIF (Atch 1e & h).
- e. On or about 2 February 2001, you failed to report for duty on time. For this incident you received a Record of Individual Counseling (RIC) dated 2 February 2001 (Atch 1f).

- f. On or about 16 November 2000, you failed to report for duty on time. You were also were intoxicated for duty. For this incident you received an LOR dated 21 November 2000. A UIF was established and this document was placed in it (Atch 1g & h).
- 3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.
- 4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult ( ), Area Defense Counsel, Ramstein AB, GE, Building 2111, DSN 480-2182/2492 on JUCO You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 26 Sept 2002 at 1200L hours unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report in uniform with your medical records and an escort to the Ramstein AB Clinic, Physical Exams, Building 2121 on West of 1300 for the evaluation. If you wear glasses, you must bring them with you. If you wear contacts, you must be able to remove them.
- 8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the orderly room.
- 9. Although not a reason for discharge, Memos for Record (MFRs) for failure to make your Military Star Card payment and failure to report for work at the appointed place and time and the denial of your award of the Air Force Good Conduct Medal are additional considerations, and are therefore attached.
