AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2005-00435

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant received a General Discharge for Pattern of Misconduct – Conduct Prejudicial to Good Order and Discipline.

Applicant contends that at the time of his service, he was not financially sound and is now hindered from getting certain jobs because of this mistake he has learned from. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15, five Letters of Reprimand, and two Letters of Counseling, for misconduct to include tardiness, failure to be available for a recall, dereliction of duty, and numerous instances of financial irresponsibility. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. Although the Board was sympathetic as to the impact the characterization of his discharge was having on the applicant, this is not a matter of inequity or impropriety which would warrant an upgrade. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members, and the characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for a pattern of misconduct consisting of conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline. The authorities for this action are AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.50.2. If my recommendation is approved, your service may be characterized as honorable or under honorable conditions (general). I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (general).

2. My reasons for this action are:

a. On or about 24 Jul 99, your monthly DPP payment was past due. The total amount due was \$86.00, which included \$32.00 of the payment due on 8 Jul 99. Additionally, you owed \$608.11 to the Metropolitan Educational Enterprises, Inc., and you had not made a payment since Jan 99. For this you received a Letter of Reprimand, dated 3 Aug 99. (Atch 1a)

b. On or about 28 Jun 99, you were in excess of sixty days past due on your car loan. The total amount past due was \$475.66. For this you received a Letter of Reprimand, dated 30 Jul 99, which was put in your Unfavorable Information File. (Atch 1b)

c. On or about 13 Jan 99, you wrote a check to the Army and Air Force Exchange Service in the amount of \$20.49 and thereafter dishonorably failed to maintain sufficient funds in the Pentagon Credit Union for payment in full of said check upon presentment. For this you received an Article 15 (AF Form 3070), dated 11 Mar 99. (Atch lc)

d. On or about 22 Feb 99, you were in excess of sixty days past due on your Exchange Credit Account (DPP). The total amount past due was \$77.00. For this you received a Letter of Reprimand, dated 9 Mar 99. (Atch 1d)

e. On or about 1 Mar 99, you neglected to accomplish your assigned duties. Some of the duties, you failed to accomplish are as follows: you failed to return tickets to TMO for a canceled TDY, you failed to accomplish a Visit Notice as directed, you failed to complete Courier letters required for an exercise, and you failed to destroy manuals and disks for software as directed. For this you received a Letter of Counseling, dated 1 Mar 99. (Atch 1e)

f. On or about 2 Mar 98, you were not available for recall during a generation exercise (GENEX) as required of you. For this you received a Letter of Counseling, dated 4 Mar 98. (Atch 1f)

g. On or about 18 Dec 97, you <u>did not pay</u> reparation costs pursuant to a previous vehicular accident agreement made between you and Mrs.: This was a third separate occasion in which to failed to pay. Additionally on or about 20 Nov 97, you made the payment with a check that had insufficient funds to cover the amount paid. For this you received a Letter of Reprimand, dated 22 Dec 97. (Atch 1g)

h. On or about 24 Nov 97, you failed to show up on time to your appointed place of duty to wit: 509 OSS Squadron. For this you received a Letter of Reprimand, dated 24 Nov 97. (Atch 1h)

3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising Special Court-Martial convening authority or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.

4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Captain at building 509 on <u>23 Aug</u> 99 at <u>0900</u>. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.


5. You have the right to submit extendents in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by $\frac{3}{76}$ Airs 99 unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.

7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to Physical Exams at <u>0920</u> on <u>18 Aug 99</u> for the examination.

8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in your Orderly Room.
