AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2005-00480

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: The request for upgrade of discharge to honorable is denied. However, the discharge is upgraded to general.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by applicant substantiates an impropriety that would justify a change of discharge. However, based upon the record and evidence provided by applicant, the Board finds the applicant's discharge was too harsh and approved an upgrade of discharge to General.

ISSUE:

After a thorough and complete consideration of the information provided by the applicant and contained in the records, the DRB concluded there was sufficient mitigation to substantiate upgrading the discharge. Specifically, the Board found that the characterization was too harsh. Although the DRB did not condone the misconduct of the applicant, a General discharge was deemed appropriate and equitable.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

However, in view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that the overall quality of applicant's service is more accurately reflected by a General discharge.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

- 1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for a pattern of misconduct. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.50. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority to support this recommendation are attached.
- 2. My reason for this action is that, on 11 May 2005, I preferred the following charges against you and on 19 May 2005, Colonel the Mission Support Group Commander, referred your case to trial by summary court-martial:
- a. You did, within the continental United States, on or about 22 July 2004, without authority, fail to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty, to wit: the XOXW Division Office, Pentagon, Arlington, Virginia.
- b. You, who knew or should have known of your duties within the continental United States, on divers occasions, between on or about 16 July 2004 and on or about 23 July 2004, were derelict in the performance of those duties in that you willfully failed to refrain from using your government travel card for personal expenses, as it was your duty to do, by spending over \$4,500 for personal use.
- c. You did, at or near Oxon Hill, Maryland, between on or about 1 January 2004 and on or about 21July 2004, wrongfully possess a firearm which was not registered to you in the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record, in violation of 26 United States Code Section 5861(d).
- d. You did, at or near Oxon Hill, Maryland, between on or about 1 January 2004 and on or about 21 July 2004, wrongfully possess a firearm having the serial number required by Chapter 53, Title 26, United States Code, obliterated, removed, changed, or altered, in violation of 26 United States Code Section 5861(h).
- e. For this, you were convicted at Summary Court-Martial and received a sentence of reduction to the grade of senior airman.
- 3. This action could result in your separation under other than honorable conditions (UOTHC). I am recommending you receive a UOTHC discharge. The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction or a higher authority will make the final decision in this matter. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and will probably be denied enlistment in any component of the armed forces. Any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.
