AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2006-00116

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable, to change the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge, change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code are denied.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE:

Applicant contends that he was told at his date of separation that he could reenlist in two years. He has expressed a desire to reenlist in the armed forces. The records indicated the applicant received four Letters of Reprimand, two Records of Individual Counseling and an AETC Form 125A for misconduct. The applicant was administratively disciplined for failure to go, failure to keep dormitory room in inspection order, smoking cigarettes out of uniform, violation of Phase by smoking cigarettes, failure to obey a lawful order and being disrespectful to authority. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

If he can provide additional documented information to substantiate an issue, the applicant should consider exercising his right to make a personal appearance before the Board. If he should choose to exercise his right to a personal appearance hearing, the applicant should be prepared to provide the DRB with factual evidence of the inequity and any exemplary post-service accomplishments as well as any contributions to the community.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or under honorable conditions (general). I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (general).

2: My reason for this action are:

- a. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 21 Sep 97, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: SAFBI 36-2902, paragraph 5.5.5, by failing to return to and remain in your assigned dormitory room from 2100-0400. For this misconduct you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR) on 22 Sep 97.
- b. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 20 Sep 97, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: SAFBI 36-2902, paragraph 2.1.3, by failing to keep your dormitory room in inspection order at all times. For this misconduct you received an AF Form 174, Record of Individual Counseling on 22 Sep 97.
- c. You, who knew of your duties at Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 20 Sep 97, were derelict in the performance of those duties by failing to report to your appointed place of duty, to wit: Military Training Day. For this misconduct you received an AF Form 17 on 22 Sep 97.
- d. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 11 Sep 97, fail to obey a lawful order and were disrepectful to an NCO. For this misconduct you received an LOR on 12 Sep 97.
- e. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 6 Sep 97, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: SAFBI 36-2902, paragraph 2.1.12, by smoking in the dormitory parking lot. For this misconduct you received an LOR on 12 Sep 97.

f. You did, at or near Sheppard AFB TX, on or about 25 Jul 97, violate a lawful general instruction, to wit: SAFB 36-2902, paragraphs 1.2.12 and 5.2.2, by smoking and wearing civilian clothes. For this misconduct you received an LOR on 29 Jul 97.

Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and will probably be denied enlistment in any component of the armed forces.

- 3. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Area Defense Counsel on 29 Sep 97 at 0800. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.
- 4. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 2 Oct 97 unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.
- 5. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.
- 6. You were scheduled for a medical examination on 23 Sep 97.
- 7. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208, is available for your use in the Military Training Flight administration office.
- 8. Execute the attached acknowledgment and return it to me immediately.
