AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2006-00176

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE:

Although not explicitly stated, applicant contends his discharge was inequitable because it was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received an Article 15, three Letters of Reprimand, and a Letter of Counseling for misconduct. The applicant received an Article 15 for committing sodomy with a child under the age of 16 and for wrongfully communicating to an airman that he would deal with him with a Glock 40 handgun. He was punished with a reduction in grade to Airman, restriction to Edwards AFB for 30 days, and 30 days of extra duty. He was administratively disciplined for failure to go on two separate occasions, missing an appointment, speeding, and failure to obey a lawful regulation. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the misconduct was a significant departure from conduct expected of all military members. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, para 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your discharge will be characterized as honorable or general. I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (general).

2. My reasons for discharging you for minor disciplinary infractions are:

a. On 23 Feb 99, you failed to report to your appointed place of duty, as evidenced by a Letter of Couseling, dated 24 Feb 99. (Atch 1.1)

b. On 12 Jul 99, you were cited for speeding on Edwards AFB, going 78 mph in a 60 mph zone, as evidenced by a Letter of Reprimand, dated 16 Jul 99. (Atch 1.2)

c. On 8 Nov 99, you willfully disregarded shop policy by eating in the GE Section, as evidenced by a Letter of Counseling, dated 9 Nov 99. (Atch 1.3)

d. On 15 May 00, you committed sodomy with a child under the age of 16 years and on 10 Jun 00, you communicated a threat to A1C _______, as evidenced by an Article 15 and an Unfavorable Information File, dtd 11 Aug 00. (Atch 1.4)

e. On 24 Aug 00, you failed to go to your appointed place of duty, as evidenced by a Letter of Reprimand, dated 28 Aug 00, an Unfavorable Information File entry and a control roster action, dtd 6 Sep 00. (Atch 1.5)

3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising special court-martial convening authority (SPCM) jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force, and if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force.

4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult <u>Capt</u> at Bldg 2670 on <u>85efoo</u> at <u>10.30</u>. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.

5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by <u>205<<u>P00</u></u> unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.

7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the Physical Examination Section, Flight Surgeon's Office, Bldg 3925 at 0730 on N|A for the examination.

8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the Orderly Room.
